

SEMI-ANNUAL REVIEW

Chapters should review the Crisis Management Plan with the entire chapter once a semester, and determine an Emergency Meeting Place in case of fire, lock-down of chapter house, or other emergency.

CRISIS STEPS

- 1. Get emergency help, if needed, by calling 911.
- 2. The Number I, or next available officer, collects all pertinent information (involved parties, time, location, hospitalizations, etc.). Simultaneity, visit KappaAlphaOrder.org/Risk and contact the proper staff that are listed and complete the crisis notice form.
- 3. Assess situation with appropriate staff and volunteers.
- 4. Complete and submit Incident Report given by the NAO.
- 5. Continue to follow instructions as given by the NAO.
