Level I: 3.50 – 4.00

No extra study hours needed
Complimentary Dinner

Level II: 3.00 – 3.49

2 study hours per week
May be either study sheet or proctored

Level III: 2.75 – 2.99

4 study hours per week
At least 2 must be proctored

Level IV: 2.50 – 2.74

6 study hours per week
At least 3 must be proctored

Level V: 0.00 – 2.49

8 study hours per week
At least 4 must be proctored
Will not be allowed to attend a Social Events (according to KA Law)

Note: According to the University of Tennessee IFC Laws, no member that records a GPA below a 2.3 will be allowed to initiate

Note: Those that do not complete their study hours will forfeit the privilege of attending all Social, Brotherhood, or Intramural Events until the hours are made up.

Incentive and Reward Programs

Plaque for Most Improved GPA

- Cannot be awarded to the same person two semesters in a row

Scholarship Dinner

- A free dinner will be rewarded to the brothers who have a GPA of 3.5 or higher.

Top 3 GPA's

- The 3 brothers with the highest GPAs will be rewarded with cash.
- Money will come from \$5 from every brother in the chapter and will be included in the Dues of each member.
 - 1st Place: 60% of total
 - 2nd Place: 25% of total
 - 3rd Place: 15% of total
- Cannot win first, second or third in back to back semesters

The "A" Train

- At the beginning of each meeting every brother who received an A on a test, quiz, paper or exam will put a piece of paper with their name on it into a jar and at the end of each month a name will be drawn.
